

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE WOOD RIVER FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

Call Meeting to Order: Chairman Commissioner Jay Bailet called the meeting of the Wood River Fire Protection District to order on July 15, 2020 at Wood River Fire District Station 3, 11053 State Hwy 75, Bellevue, Idaho at 3:00 PM.

Attendance: Commissioners Jay Bailet, Steven Garman, Dennis Kavanagh, Chief Ron Bateman, Office Manager Stephanie Jaskowski

Consent Agenda:

Action Item: Approve and Sign Old Meeting Minutes from the Regular Meeting on June 17, 2020. **Commissioner Garman motioned to approve the minutes from June 17, 2020 Regular Meeting, Commissioner Kavanagh seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.**

Action Item: Approve and Sign June 2020 Payables. **Commissioner Garman motioned to approve the June 2020 Payables; Commissioner Kavanagh seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.**

Open session for public comments: Commissioner Bailet thanked Commissioner Garman for his assistance with Lt. Eric Mathieu repairing the Yellow Repeater on Baldy. Commissioner Garman commended Lt. Mathieu for his knowledge, expertise and resourcefulness completed the repairs.

Ketchum Rural Fire District Commissioner Earl Engelmann spoke to future collaboration between districts, plans to improve Greenhorn Station facilities to potentially benefit both districts and improve service to the communities, both operationally and facility wise. He would like to encourage future discussions going forward. Commissioners held discussion supporting the opportunity and potential benefits of working together and look forward to more conversations.

Sun Valley Fire Chief Taan Robrahn spoke to potential possibilities of expanding the land size working with ITD for donation or long-term lease at the Greenhorn site to increase facilities for additional employee housing and/or equipment storage. Sun Valley Assistant Chief Rich Bauer spoke to how well the employee housing has worked out for the department with the community they have been developing.

Chief Ron Bateman's Report:

ITEM: MOU with Local 4923 Re: Step Plan (Public Hearing)

DESCRIPTION: On a couple of occasions we've bumped into some hurdles with the step plan in the current collective bargaining agreement. We navigated it with promotions for CPT Sears and LT DeMoe, but we needed to be a bit more official with the annual step requirement. I've attached a memorandum of understanding that I crafted on Monday after conversation with President Huntsman since mid-June.

ACTION PROPOSED: *No action necessary; for information only.*

ITEM: FY 2021 Budget Presentation to the BCAD (Chief's Report)

DESCRIPTION: I don't need to write a whole lot more on the specifics of the draft of the FY 2021 Budget and my presentation to the BCAD. They met yesterday and, since I wasn't feeling well, I joined via computer. Stephanie attended in person. More or less, I read the letter that I had sent to the County with the budget last week – the same one that I included as an attachment to my weekly email last Friday. I will include a copy of that report with this report, so it's part of WRFR history / public record.

The BCAD was appreciative of the depth (of my letter) and our commitment to improving service. Comms. McCleary and Fosbury spoke first and Comm. Greenberg commented last. He wanted to schedule an additional meeting with the fire chiefs and County Administrator Derek Voss about potential additional funding. Derek cautioned about making increases that were more than one-time. My simple assessment would be that Mr. Voss was just being mindful of the financial ramifications of committing to additional contributions in perpetuity.

I haven't had a lot of time to think about how exactly to approach additional conversations with BCAD. As you know, I concluded my letter with an attempt to open the door to more funding *this year*, cautious not "paint them into a corner." I think I was successful in that. You are also aware that I've found a way to fund it in FY 2021, but it's not a permanent solution. Comm. Greenberg, Chief McLaughlin (KFD) and I had just begun to have a conversation about just this matter before the COVID-19 lockdown began. I have begun to think more deliberately and have come up with the real question – ***How do we craft a plan that has 4 people on duty 24/7/365 that isn't temporary?*** The complex and adaptive challenge is that the solution doesn't lie with just the BCAD or Local 4923 or HFD (JPA) or other partners (KRFPD) or an election question. It's some combination of all of these...and a solution in one area isn't mutually exclusive from another.

ACTION PROPOSED: *No action is needed or requested, but I did want to encourage discussion and dialogue from the BoFCs with respect to where and how we might speak to any additional funding from the BCAD in FY 2021.*

The commissioners had a brief discussion for clarifications in developing the budget and where we might be able to work out with the Ambulance district additional revenue based on improving services and response time making a difference.

ITEM: Election Question (Chief's Report)

DESCRIPTION: I haven't been able to do much, if anything, with regards to a potential election question since our last meeting. Comm. Kavanagh has worked diligently to set up a meeting with him and me and some Ketchum officials, but it hasn't come to fruition. I have talked, informally, with our membership and the more I think about it, the more I believe that trying to get a plan together about *how* to use any additional revenue needs more time to prepare. A lot of what we've done thus far has focused on the present and the near future (FY 2021), but now that we are talking about a strategic future it needs to be done methodically and intentionally.

ACTION PROPOSED: I would like the BoFCs to consider establishing / participating in a committee or work group that meets and begins discussions in earnest the question of what we want / need with regards to a potential election question. ***Subject to questions and discussion, I would ask for general direction from the Board. No formal action necessary.***

The commissioners held a discussion and determined to hold off until 2021 to allow time to properly develop a successful plan for an election question.

Old Business:

Update on De-Annexation of Ketchum Rural Fire District Greenhorn Gulch Station property out of the Wood River Fire Protection District. Chief Bateman authorized Attorney John Seiller with cooperation of KRFPD to put together the legal description of the property and properly advertise it for an Open Hearing on August 19, 2021 for a de-annexation.


New Business: Commissioner Kavanagh is working with Neil Bradshaw to arrange a meeting to discuss their experiences with their recent election question.

Commissioner Garman requested our radio partners on the Yellow One Repeater repairs (Hailey & Bellevue) contribute to the expenses and Chief Bateman confirmed they will (Hailey at 31%, Bellevue 19%). Discussion was held going forward for additional services based on what would be affordable. Commissioner Garman recommended reviewing current portable radio inventory for upgrading equipment looking at costs and efficiencies. Discussion was held regarding the possibility of grants available to assist improving our communication inventory, potentially going together with our valley partners.

Any Other Business: None

Adjourn: Commissioner Garman motioned to adjourn the meeting and Commissioner Kavanagh seconded the motion for Adjournment at 3:55 pm. All in favor, Motion carried.

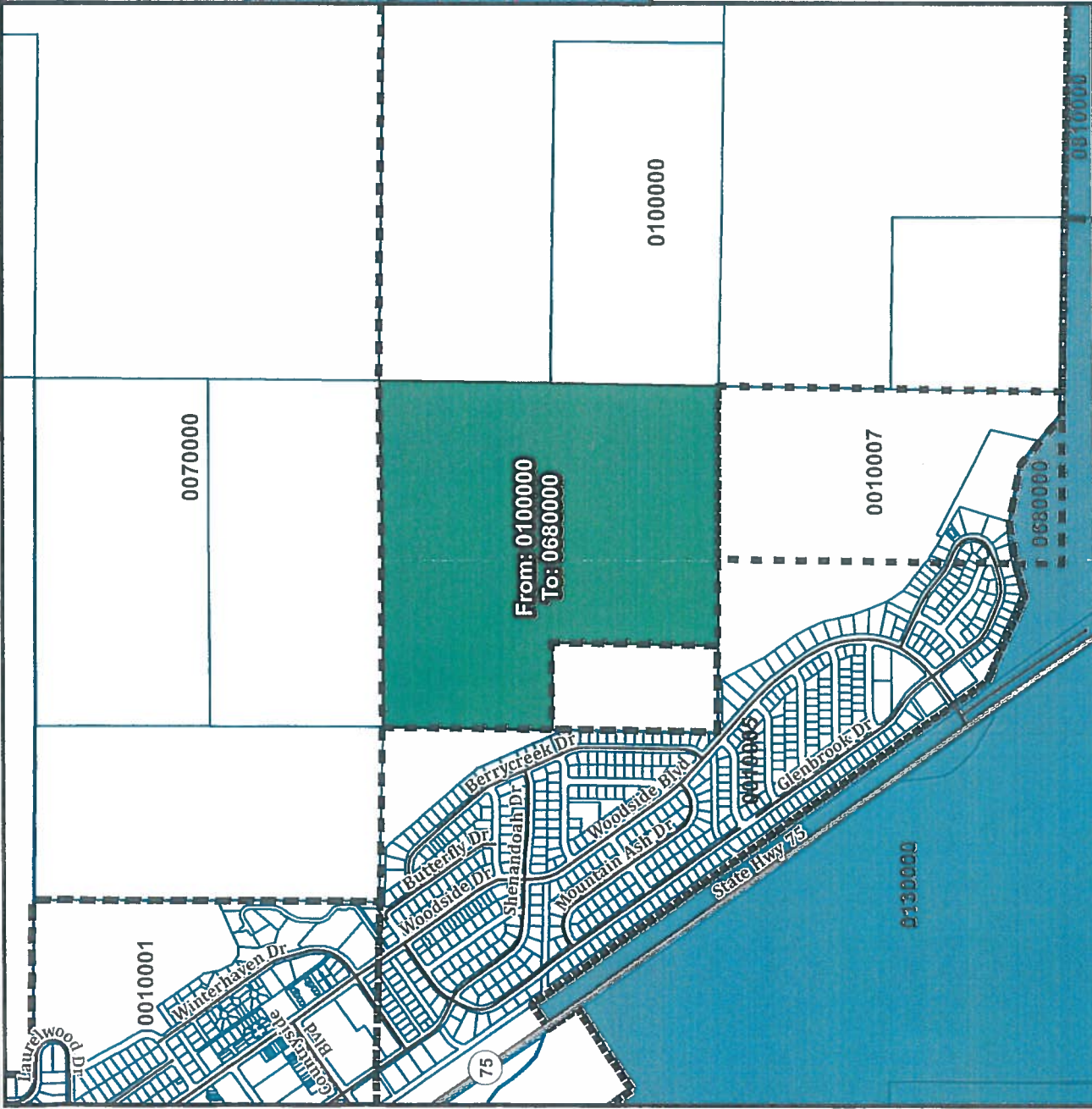



Effective Year 2021 Proposed
