# MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE WOOD RIVER FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

**Call Meeting to Order:** Chairman Commissioner Jay Bailet called the meeting of the Wood River Fire Protection District to order on March 17, 2021 at Wood River Fire District Station 3, 11053 State Hwy 75, Bellevue, Idaho at 3:02 PM.

**Attendance:** Commissioners Jay Bailet, Steven Garman, Dennis Kavanagh, Chief Ron Bateman, Office Manager Stephanie Jaskowski

Open session for public comments: Cory Chalmers (Retired Firefighter Captain), Redgy Christensen (Insurance Sales), Dana Orzel, Mark Acker; Croy Canyon residents voiced their concerns regarding the location of the purposed Croy Creek Campground by the City of Hailey and the Grant they are in process of obtaining. They detailed their background and experiences with fires in the Croy Canyon and other local fires over the last 30 years. They are vehemently against this purposed development citing poor location, 33 dry campsites with fire rings with only one water (drinking) source and no fire suppression infrastructure. They are worried about the increased traffic congestion on foot and vehicles in this area and how it would increase fire hazard risks. Redgy Christensen cited potential increased insurance costs to the approximate 75 residents in this canyon due to this purposed development. In addition, they voiced apprehension to disturbing wildlife and their habitat and conservation in this area. When a fire event occurs in this congested area, evacuation on a dangerous road and restricted bridge access could have devastating outcomes. They requested Wood River Fire Protection District join them in fighting this purposed development due to the tremendous fire and safety risk this project would be to the Croy Canyon and Hailey's citizens and their properties near this project. They agree there should be new Hailey Campground, but in a location more suitable than this purposed area.

Keri York, Land Program Manager with the Land Trust, clarified they have been listening to public concerns of this nature with this project to work on alternatives to reduce fire and safety risks. They will be holding public meetings on April 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup>. They encouraged input from all at these meetings.

A letter from retired WRFPD Chief Bart Lassman was read, he respectfully requests the commissioners take a proactive role in the plan review process for this proposed project citing determining Fire Protection responsibility (the project located in this District and not within the city limits), Fire Code Enforcement, General liability in regards to fire damages and Cost Share liabilities on this Fire District, mutual aid partners and federal wildland authorities, BLM, USFS.

The Commissioners held discussion; Commissioners and Chief Bateman agreed with these concerns presented. Commissioner Bailet asked Commissioner Garman to work with Chief Bateman to develop a strategy/resolution and craft a letter of the district's position to resist this development in this area with these potential congestion, fire and safety risks and a discussion of an fire event cost share liabilities with the City of Hailey, The Land Trust and County Commissioners.

Action Item: Approve and Sign Old Meeting Minutes from the Regular Meeting on February 17, 2021. Commissioner Garman motioned to approve the minutes from February 17, 2021 Regular Meeting, Commissioner Kavanagh seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Action Item: Approve and Sign February 2021 Payables. Commissioner Garman motioned to approve and sign the February 2021 Payables; Commissioner Kavanagh seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

#### **Chiefs Report:**

ITEM: Operational and Financial Updates (Chief's Report)

DESCRIPTION: Operational. As of March 16<sup>th</sup>, there have been 167 days in FY 2021 (4008 hours) and 3 days (72 hours) without 4-person staffing. Therefore, we are up from 97.7% last month and just a touch under my goal of 98.5% <u>at 98.2% of FY 2021 at 4-person staffing</u>. If we can dodge having a 3-person staffing day between now and our April 21<sup>st</sup> board meeting, we will be at my goal.

Financial. Last week, Stephanie processed our 12<sup>th</sup> payroll of the fiscal year. Our pace after nearly half of the FY:

Line Item 6010 – Line Personnel	\$705,525 / \$734,681 (96.03%)
Line Item 6020 – TFT Personnel	\$164,736 / \$169,728 (97.05%)
Line Item 6030 – PT / POC Personnel	\$143,569 / \$129,648 (110.73%)
Line Item 6040 – Admin Personnel	\$210,783 / \$214,720 (98.16%)

Total \$1,225,913 / \$1,252,377 (97.88%)

As a reminder, personnel costs (including benefits, etc.) are 83.4% (\$1,841,069 / \$2,207,240) of our FY 2021 Operational Budget. Nearly halfway through FY 2021, we are on pace with personnel costs to finish at \$1,818,252 / \$1,841,069 (98.7%). This is down just over a tenth of a percentage point from my Chief's Report in January.

ACTION PROPOSED: No action is needed or requested, but I do want to encourage discussion and dialogue from the BoFCs with respect to any financial and operational reality.

Update on Hailey Croy Exchange Structure Fire: Chief reviewed the course of action, job well done protecting other structures. Investigators are on scene. There were difficulties with Dispatch as they just converted to a new system and paging issues developed. Corrections are in progress.

ITEM: Stryker Cot / Load System Warranty (Chief's Report / Action Item)

DESCRIPTION: As you know, LT Haavik has been working extensively with the Stryker cot and loading systems, as our 1-year warranty will be expiring in about a month. We initiated a conversation about who should incur the cost of the extended warranty, if desired. Is it like an oil change and a responsibility of each contract holder or, since the cost is substantial, should the cost be borne by the owner – the BCAD? The main consideration here is if the maintenance is on each individual contract holder that we need to keep our cots. Well, what does that mean? It means that often, when we rendezvous with Carey, we swap cots (as opposed to moving the patient). If the BCAD does not purchase the additional warranty and we decide to pursue it for WRFR, our cots would be covered and not Carey's – so we would want to keep ours.

The information that LT Haavik has obtained from Stryker has been forwarded to the County. It has not been on their agenda for decision yet. My best estimate is the "bumper-to-bumper" cost would be around \$4,800 / year (for the next three years). In FY 2021, this cost has not been budgeted for and would occur before May 1<sup>st</sup>. Although tight, it could be pulled from Capital or Contingency,

ACTION PROPOSED: Should we absorb this cost, if not covered by BCAD? Subject to any discussion, I would ask for a roll call vote.

Commissioners held discussion. Chief was directed to get with the Ambulance District to review this extended warranty on these items with those commissioners to have them pick up this expense.

**New Business:** None

Executive Session: Commissioner Garman motioned to enter into Executive Session to deliberate regarding an acquisition of an interest in real property [Idaho Code § 74-206 (1) (c)] at 3:44 pm and consider contract matters [Idaho Code § 74-206 (1) (j)] Commissioner Kavanagh seconded the motion, all in favor, Motion carried.

Commissioner Garman motioned to exit Executive Session at 5:45 pm, Commissioner Kavanagh seconded the motion, all in favor, Motion carried.

**Action Item: Discussion or Action Upon Executive Session:** Discussion held; no Action taken on contract matters.

Commissioner Garman motioned to have Chief start crafting and making an offer of \$850,000 for the 2.46 acres land parcel from the Church to purchase for a new building site for Station 1. Commissioner Kavanagh seconded the motion. All in favor, motioned carried.

- 4. Cost Share liability on the WRFPD. Mutual Aid partners and federal wildland fire authorities, BLM, USFS etc.
